Schedule a Visit

St. Clair County Jail offers **on-site and remote video visitation**.

All visitors must register at:

You must:

- Create an account
- Register as a visitor
- Schedule visits at least 24 hours in advance
- Visits may be scheduled up to 14 days in advance

All visits are monitored and recorded.

Up to three (3) visitors are allowed per visit.

Visitation Schedule

On-Site Visits:

Sunday through Thursday

Remote Visits:

Seven (7) days a week

1:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

(No visits during dinner hour at 5:00 p.m.)

You may schedule as many remote visits as you like, as long as it does not interfere with facility operations.

Important Arrival Requirements

- Arrive 45 minutes before your scheduled visit.
- Adults must present a valid, government-issued photo ID.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult guardian (18 or older).
- Minors may not be left unattended in any area.

VISITING RULES AND RESTRICTIONS

- All visits are non-contact.
- No firearms or weapons allowed.

- No visitors who are intoxicated.
- All visitors are subject to search.
- No items may be passed to detainees.
- No items may be carried into the visitation area.
- No provocative or revealing clothing.
- No provocative, pornographic, immoral, or illegal behavior.
- Violations may result in suspension or permanent ban from visitation.
